PURPOSE

To ensure the safety of all staff, students and school visitors in the event of an emergency or critical incident situation.

POLICY

To inform the school community that Blackburn English Language School (ELS) has a current Emergency Management Plan (EMP) that contains a risk assessment that addresses hazards and potential threats to the school and which covers the four components of preparedness, prevention, response and recovery.

Blackburn ELS

- ensures that staff, students and the school community have a clear understanding of the EMP and its procedures,
- ensures that staff, students and the school community are trained so that they know what they are required to do during an emergency,
- tests emergency arrangements at regular intervals to ensure that procedures work and everyone learns emergency protocols

The school's Emergency Management Plan

- is completed using the online EMP,
- describes actions to take before, during and after an emergency to ensure the ongoing safety of staff, students and others,
- covers all circumstances when the school is responsible for student safety, such as school excursions to ensure staff and student safety and that students are supervised at all times,
- uses the Student Activity Locator to record student activities and excursions that occur outside the school
- is reviewed at least annually by 1 September and following an emergency or critical incident

CONTACTS

Incidents assessed as Low or Medium can be reported directly into eduSafe Plus (staff login required) by the principal (or delegate). The principal (or delegate) is to contact the Incident Support and Operations Centre (ISOC) on 1800 126 126 to report 'High' or 'Extreme' severity incidents for support (report for support).

REVIEW

This policy is reviewed annually and/or following an emergency or crisis.
